Description

Dr. Alan Simmons and colleagues are conducting a study to investigate the effects of neurological and psychological trauma following combat events. Participation will involve 3-6 visits over an 18-month period, during which participants will complete questionnaires, undergo various cognitive testing, engage in clinical interviews and have brain images collected in an MRI scanner.

Requirements

We are looking for veterans with a history of military combat and who are able to undergo MRI testing (e.g., have no metal parts inside the body).

Benefits

Participants will aid in the advancement of our understanding of PTSD and combat stress. There will be up to \$550 in compensation.
