Description

Across 2 in-person study visits at the La Jolla VA, you will complete cognitive testing, questionnaires, interviews, and an MRI scan (no radiation). Visit 1 is about 5.5 hours and Visit 2 is about 3.5 hours. It is possible to do the informed consent process and some of the questionnaires remotely, which will reduce Visit 1 by 1 hour.

Requirements

Veterans aged 21-55 WITH **OR WITHOUT** a history a MILD traumatic brain injury who can safely enter an MRI scanner. No prior history of other neurological disorders, Type I Diabetes, or developmental learning disability.

Benefits

Payment of up to \$160. The findings will lay the foundation for increased understanding cognitive difficulties after head injury and identify neuroimaging markers useful to evaluate treatment response in future clinical trials
